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PROGRAM PROCEDURES

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Applicant must be a primary member (first owner named on the account) in good standing with Blackhawk Community Credit Union.
- Applicant must be a 2019 graduating senior from a high school or a home school located in communities served by a Blackhawk Community Credit Union branch.
- Applicant must be planning to attend an accredited public or private college, community college or technical college. Awards will not be disbursed until the student is accepted and enrolled in an accredited institution.
- Previous winners are not eligible for the Blackhawk Scholarship Program.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicant must submit:
 - Completed application including a listing of all extracurricular activities (sports, clubs, hobbies, etc.), volunteer activities and community involvement (personal, school, church, etc.), leadership experiences, work experiences, awards and honors, and other relevant personal information.
 - High school transcript with GPA from the end of the most recent school year. Transcripts may be mailed separately as long as they are postmarked by March 15, 2019 to qualify.

- A video, 3 minutes or less answering the following:
 1. Explain the importance of your field of study and how it can change today or the future? Tell us about you and why you chose your field of study and school.
 2. Community – What does it mean to you? How has the community impacted or influenced you?

All application materials must be uploaded by March 15, 2019 to www.bhccu.org. Application materials can be uploaded by scrolling to the bottom of the homepage and clicking on the "Secure File Upload" link. Fill out the secure upload form and attach your application materials. Late and incomplete entries will not be accepted.

- Blackhawk Community Credit Union has the right to amend any of the above rules to ensure fairness in the awarding of the scholarships.

ADMINISTRATIVE/AWARD PROCEDURES:

- Scholarship funds will be paid only to the school's business office. Funds are to be used in the 2019-20 school year for tuition or books. Any funds not used for these purposes will be forfeited. In January of each year, Blackhawk Community Credit Union is required to file form 1099 with the IRS, which reports amounts paid to reduce student loans during the previous year. The student will be mailed a copy of Form 1099 and may be required to report on a tax return any scholarship winnings applied to student loans. We recommend that the student consult a tax advisor.

JUDGING:

- Judging will be completed by a panel of impartial judges. All decisions are final.
- Consideration will be viewed in scholastic standing, personal video, volunteering, awards, work/life balance and extracurricular activities.
- The video will be evaluated on the following:
Content Creativity/Originality Community Involvement
- All scholarship applications become the property of Blackhawk Community Credit Union and may be published.



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Blackhawk Community Credit Union is committed to the higher education goals of the credit union's youth members. We are awarding two Presidential scholarships of \$2,000 each and sixteen scholarships of \$1,000 each for the 2019-20 school year.
